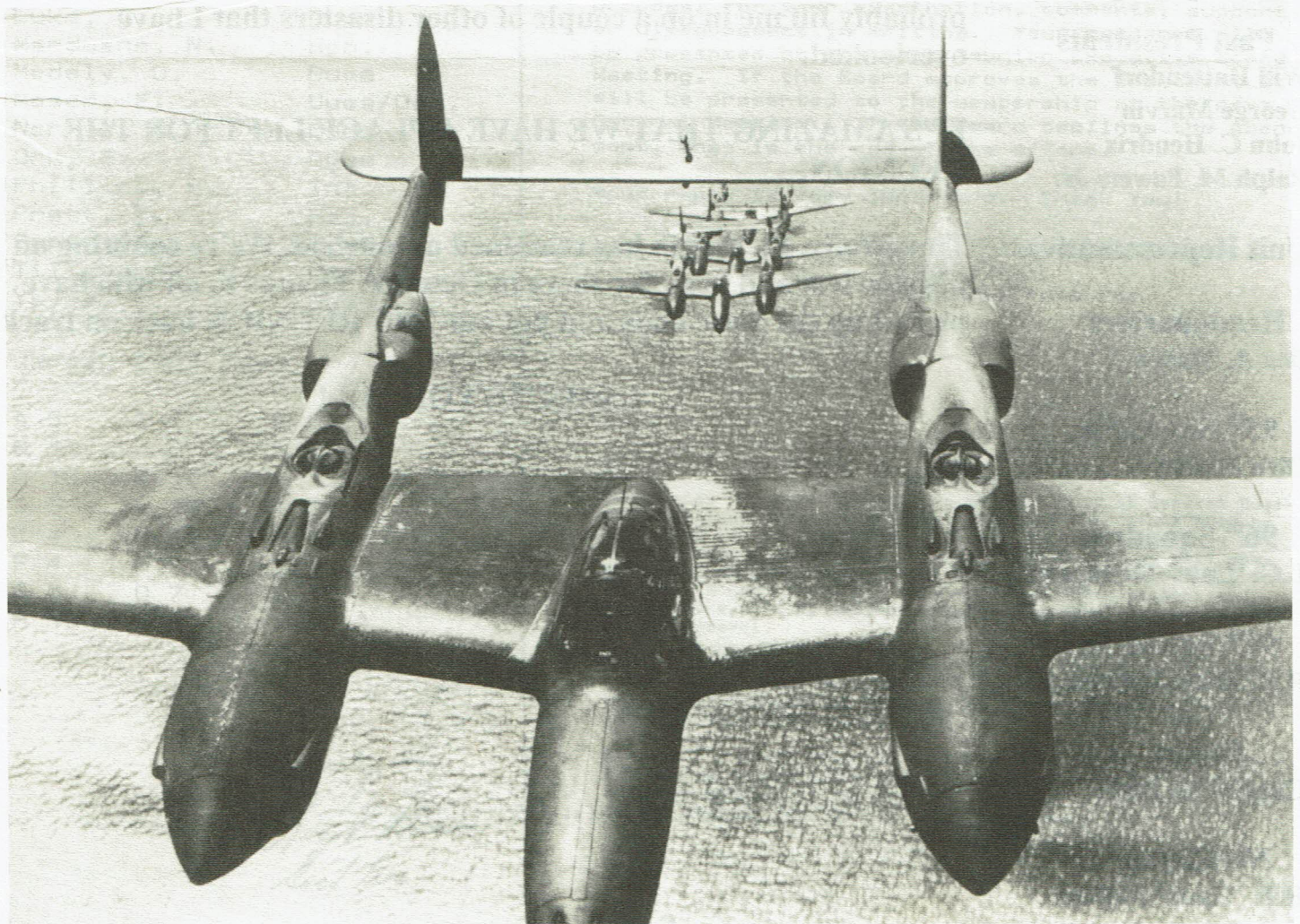

**Article 9 - Amendments**

Amendments to these By-Laws may be made only at General Business Meetings during Reunions. Proposed amendments must be submitted to the Executive Committee in writing 30 days or more prior to a Reunion. The Executive Committee will submit the proposed amendments in writing to the Membership for action. A two thirds majority of the members present and voting at a General Business Meeting is required for approval or disapproval.

These By-Laws, as amended, were adopted by a two thirds majority vote of the membership at the General Business Meeting of the Association held on the "Queen Mary", October 9, 1989, in Long Beach, California.

Article 3 - Membership and Dues was amended and adopted by a two thirds majority vote of the membership at the General Business meeting of the Association held on September 7, 1996, at the Holiday Inn, Dedham, Massachusetts.

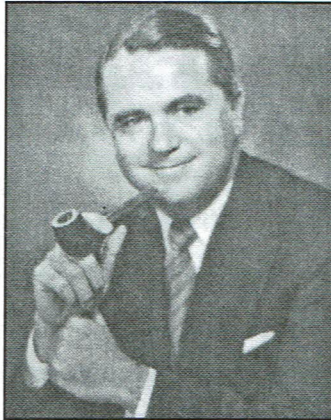

# Thomas M. Judd

May 18, 1920 ~ July 10, 2006

MONTEREY - Thomas M. Judd, 86, passed away on July 10, 2006, in Monterey after a brief illness. Born May 18, 1920, Tom was raised in Pasadena, California. He graduated from Princeton University in 1941 and the National War College in 1968. During WWII, Tom served as an Army Air Corps P-38 combat pilot with the highly decorated 82nd Fighter Group, 96th Fighter Squadron.



Tom was appointed a United States Foreign Service Officer in 1952, where he served until his retirement in 1977. During his tenure, he received a Meritorious Honors Award and served as Consul. His postings included Germany, Romania, Italy, Greece, Somalia and South Korea, where he was instrumental in obtaining the return of Navy Seamen from North Korea after the USS Pueblo incident.

Upon his retirement from government service, Tom settled in the Monterey area and began a second career in real estate and property management. He also performed extensive volunteer services for the AT&T Pebble Beach National Pro-Am, Meals on Wheels and the Monterey County SPCA.

Tom is survived by his children and step-children: Mary McMurtry, CA, Tom Judd, Jr., FL, Vicky Lebkicker, MD, and Bette and Michael Grace of Hollister, CA.

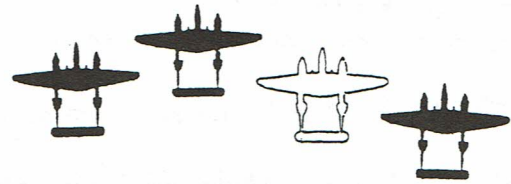
Memorials: American Cancer Society.

Senior Master Sgt. Light served his country in the United States Air Force for 26 years. He passed up a football scholarship to serve his country in World War II, Korea and Vietnam. Battles and campaigns included Rhineland, Tunisia, Sicily, Naples, Foggia, Rome, Arno, northern and southern France, Air Offensive Europe and Air Combat Balkans. During his time he was awarded the EAME Campaign Ribbon (nine bronze stars), Good Conduct Medal, American Defense Service Medal, Korean Service Medal, three Presidential Unit Citations and two Outstanding Unit Awards. His favorite aircraft he worked on was the P-38 Lightning and he was a member of the 82nd Fighter Group, 96th Squadron, and attended its reunions when he could. He also worked on the B-26, B-36 and B-52 bombers.

Besides his love for his family, Eddy loved music, reading, dancing, fishing, fixing things and his purple martins. He knew no strangers and loved to converse with anyone about any topic. He always had a smile on his face and loved to tell jokes and he went out of his way to help others. His "earthly light" has been extinguished but his "heavenly light" will shine for eternity. We loved him dearly and will miss him greatly.

# LT COL JOE DICKMAN'S Landing gear problem

I GOT A CALL ONE day that 15AF WANTED me down at BARI. Col Edwinston said he'd take me down in the B-25. We had the engines running and the mission was returning and in sight, so we taxied out and got out of there before the guys flying the mission started to land. I had a head set on, but "Curly" didn't. I was tuned to GOCART Tower, and soon <sup>LT COL</sup> JOE Dickman called GOCART and said He couldn't get his right gear down and that he was on the emergency hydraulic system. The operator in the tower told him to continue pumping. We were approaching BARI, and the Col. told me to get landing instructions, but I said let's orbit around here to see if JOE Dickman gets his gear down. Curly then put on his head set and listened and ask me if I knew what the trouble was. I said yes I know what's wrong, so he told me to call Joe and tell him what to do. I called Joe and he acknowledged. I told him to climb up to 9000' and call back which he soon did.

I told JOE that the uplock pin was still engaged and for him to pump the handpump until he could feel the pressure relieve, then pull the nose

up then push the yoke over to put negative G's on the plane, and don't get violent because I didn't want him to "Red out", and call me back when he'd caused the negative G's. He soon called back and I told him to look out and see if the right gear doors were open which was the case. Then he was to pump until he got a down and locked indication, and fly by the tower so the operator could see that all three were at the same angle. He made a normal landing.
